# Rights and Duties of PEDESTRIANS (It's the Law)







## Pedestrians are anyone on foot.

### SIGNALS

- Follow all traffic signals
- Pedestrians have the right of way when you have a Walk signal



### **CROSSING**

 If there is no crossing signal, you may proceed across a roadway when the signal light is green in your direction of travel, unless turning traffic that will cross your pathway has a green turn arrow



 Pedestrians should yield right of way to a vehicle when crossing at a point other than a crosswalk

#### **OTHER**

- · Do not leave a sidewalk if a vehicle cannot yield right of way
- You are not allowed to walk on a roadway if a sidewalk is provided and accessible to you





You should also check local ordinances to be aware of additional pedestrian policies

## Where to Walk



 $\triangle$ 

When possible walk on the right half of the crosswalk

If there is no sidewalk, you should walk on the left side of the road facing oncoming traffic





 $\triangle$ 

Do not cross the street diagonally unless authorized by a traffic signal or sign
