Right-of-Way Rules



**Pedestrians have
the right of way...**

When following
crossing signals.

(Texas Transportation Code 552.002)

At crosswalks and
intersections where
there is no stop light.

(Texas Transportation Code 552.003)



**Drivers should yield
to pedestrians...**

Who have a
signal to cross.

(Texas Transportation Code 552.002)

At intersections without
a stoplight, including
those without a painted
crosswalk.

(Texas Transportation Code
552.003 & 541.302(2))

Driver Safety Tips

1 YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS
at crosswalks and intersections (look left, right, and left again).

(Texas Transportation Code 552.003 & 552.002)

2 LOOK TWICE
near a stopped bus — people may be crossing in front of it.

3 BE CAUTIOUS
near bus stops — people may be running to catch the bus.

DON'T BLOCK THE CROSSWALK.

5 As always, **USE SIGNALS** when turning to alert pedestrians to your intentions.

(Texas Transportation Code 545.104)

6 NEVER PASS VEHICLES
stopped at a crosswalk.

7 SLOW DOWN
and be prepared to stop when entering a crosswalk.

(Texas Transportation Code 552.003c)

8 BE EXTRA CAUTIOUS
when backing up — pedestrians can move into your path.

9 OBEY TRAFFIC SIGNALS

(Texas Transportation Code 545.151a(1A))

10 BE AWARE —
put away your phone and remove earbuds, headphones, or other listening devices.
