Right-of-Way Rules



Pedestrians have the right of way...

When following crossing signals.

(Texas Transportation Code 552.002)

At crosswalks and intersections where there is no stop light.

(Texas Transportation Code 552.003)



Drivers should yield to pedestrians...

Who have a signal to cross.

(Texas Transportation Code 552.002)

At intersections without a stoplight, including those without a painted crosswalk.

(Texas Transportation Code 552.003 & 541.302(2))



Driver Safety Tips

PEDESTRIANS
at crosswalks
and intersections
(look left, right,
and left again).

(Texas Transportation Code 552.003 & 552.002)

near a stopped bus — people may be crossing in front of it.

near bus stops — people may be running to catch the bus.

NEVER
PASS
VEHICLES
stopped at
a crosswalk.

BE EXTRA
CAUTIOUS
when
backing up —
pedestrians
can move into
your path.



DON'T BLOCK THE CROSSWALK.

As always,
USE SIGNALS
when turning
to alert pedestrians to
your intentions.

(Texas Transportation Code 545.104)

SLOW DOWN

and be prepared to stop when entering a crosswalk.

(Texas Transportation Code 552.003c)

OBEY TRAFFIC SIGNALS

(Texas Transportation Code 545.151a(1A))

put away your phone and remove earbuds, headphones, or other listening devices.
